DEDICATED BID POLICE OFFICER UPDATE

Our dedicated BID police officer, Jay, continues to engage with businesses across the city centre, with more than 2,000 visits since he has been in post.

He is working with businesses on a range of concerns including safety and security advice, crime liaison and supporting live investigations.

Jay has also been instrumental in identifying opportunities to tackle wider issues in the city centre such as anti-social behaviour, working with service providers and the local authority, while also representing the important views of businesses.

Since our last update, crimes filed without investigation (crimes filed without further action) in the city centre have now dropped below the Cambridgeshire Constabulary average, which not only demonstrates the importance of Jay's role within the city but also the value of reporting all crimes.

Crime reporting in the city centre has plateaued over the last month and a truer picture of crime is emerging, which is why the emphasis should always be to report crime. Dialing 999 is for emergencies and calling 101 or online reporting online is for non-emergencies. Don't forget to also use the Peterborough Business Crime Partnership (Disc) app to share incidents and images of perpetrators.

A more accurate understanding of crime could impact the number of officers allocated to the city centre and also help the police make links, understand patterns and identify suspects.

DISC FEATURES EXPANDED



We're excited to share that our Peterborough Business Crime Partnership (Disc) system has reached a significant milestone, with more than 160 businesses signed up and individual memberships now exceeding 300.

Over the past few weeks, we have expanded some of the features to give members even more information, including details on activities and events in the city centre which may impact on businesses.

Users now have access to a new instant message feature, which supports faster communication within a specific group or area. This tool is already proving invaluable, allowing users to quickly alert each other about active, known criminals in the city centre.

The system now features an integrated direct link to the Cambridgeshire Police online reporting system, helping users save time and streamline the reporting process.

We have also recently added 'public realm' reporting, for issues like graffiti, broken or damaged public property and fly-tipping. The reports come directly to our team and we forward them to the relevant agencies or partners for action. While not published in the app, reporters can track the status of their submissions.
